RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. This tournament is certified by USBC, certification #81204. Entry is open to all USBC youth members with **4-Rivers USBC Association**.
2. Competition will be conducted in handicapped Doubles and Singles events. Squads are to be held at 12:30 pm and 3:30 pm on Saturday, March 18, 2017 and at 10:00 am and 1:30 pm on Sunday, March 19, 2017. Additional squads may be added, or deleted, if needed, at the Tournament Director's discretion and will be posted on the www.4riversusbc.com website.
3. The Doubles event will be three (3) games bowled by a team of two. The Singles will be three (3) games. A Youth bowler's first score in the Doubles event and in the Singles events will count towards the optional 6-Game All-Events.
4. **ENTRY FEE.** Each Event is \$13.00 per person (\$7.50 Lineage + \$2.00 Expenses +\$3.50 Prize Fund). An **OPTIONAL** one-time entry fee of \$1.00 per bowler for each optional 6-GAME ALL-EVENT entry and is included in the Prize Fund-Scholarship. The Prize Fund-Scholarship is refunded 100%.
5. **ENTRIES.** Doubles entries may consist of any combination of Youth boys and girls. Youth bowlers may enter the Singles event without bowling the Doubles event. A Youth bowler must enter the Doubles & Singles events to be eligible to enter the optional 6-Game All-Events. The optional 6-Game All-Events enter fee must be paid at time of the Youth bowler's first entry.
6. Youth bowlers may enter more than once (as space in regularly scheduled squads is available). A Youth bowler must compete with a different Doubles partner to qualify for scholarships in that event more than once. A Youth bowler can qualify for scholarships in Sings only once.
7. **HANDICAPS,** USBC Rule 317 shall apply. The tournament will use 100% of the difference between the youth bowler's average and 220.
8. **AVERAGES:** USBC Rule 318 shall apply. Individual averages must be based on a minimum of 12 games or more in a 4 Rivers USBC Association sanctioned Youth league at the time of bowling. The league standing sheets showing current averages from ALL 4-Rivers USBC leagues the Youth bowler competes in must be included with the entry or provided at check-in. Any Youth bowler with less than 12-games bowled in a sanctioned Youth or High School league may provide record of practice games bowled (12-game minimum) certified by a coach or bowling center. Acceptable documentation of practice games bowled is a score sheet or printout from the bowling center certifying the practice games bowled, scores, and dates. If a participant has not bowled 12 or more Youth league games, or provide acceptable documentation of practice games bowled, the Youth must use the **HIGHEST** average in Official Averages and Yearbook for the previous Season of the 4-Rivers USBC Association.
9. **SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS.** The tournament will guarantee that all awards will be awarded as scholarships through SMART account #11784. All scholarships will be awarded to participants at a ratio based on scores and number of entries in each event. In the case of ties, duplicate scholarships will be awarded.
10. All Youth bowlers must show their current USBC membership card at check-in. Duplicate cards can be printed from www.bowl.com. Check-in will begin 30 minutes prior to each squad time. Substitutes must be presented to the Tournament Director prior to check-in.
11. Tardy bowlers will start to bowl in the frame in progress at the time of their arrival. No pins are awarded for mixed frames.
12. **DRESS CODE:** No hats, tank tops or frayed jeans. No clothes with text or design depicting alcohol, drugs or tobacco products or obscene images.
13. No flash cameras, cell phones, personal music devices, hand-held games or any other items deemed distracting during bowling. The USBC Code of Conduct will be observed.
14. During tournament play, there will be no smoking or alcohol drinking allowed. Adult spectators are allowed to smoke and drink alcohol **ONLY** in designated areas away from the Youth bowlers.
15. USBC Rule 400 will apply. See Chapter 6: Tournament Rules of the USBC Playing Rules for the 2014-15 and 2015-16 seasons for any rules not covered in.
16. All disputes and protests shall be handled by the Tournament Director. Contact **Sharon Brandhorst, Association Manager** at **(636) 388-5090** or association.manager@4riversusbc.com. The decision of the Tournament Director shall be final unless an appeal is filed within 72-hours in accordance with USBC rules.
